h) $\frac{2}{11}, \frac{4}{11}, \frac{6}{11}, \frac{8}{11}$

d) $\frac{1}{12}, \frac{5}{12}, \frac{7}{12}, \frac{13}{12}$

i) $\frac{1}{6}, \frac{5}{6}, \frac{7}{6}, \frac{11}{6}$

e) $\frac{1}{8}, \frac{3}{8}, \frac{11}{8}, \frac{7}{8}$

j) $\frac{11}{9}, \frac{5}{9}, \frac{7}{9}, \frac{13}{9}$

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
