d) $\frac{7}{13}, \frac{2}{13}, \frac{11}{13}, \frac{15}{13}$

i) $\frac{1}{9}, \frac{12}{9}, \frac{7}{9}, \frac{11}{9}$

e) $\frac{13}{15}, \frac{19}{15}, \frac{11}{15}, \frac{8}{15}$

j) $\frac{15}{14}, \frac{11}{14}, \frac{9}{14}, \frac{13}{14}$

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
